



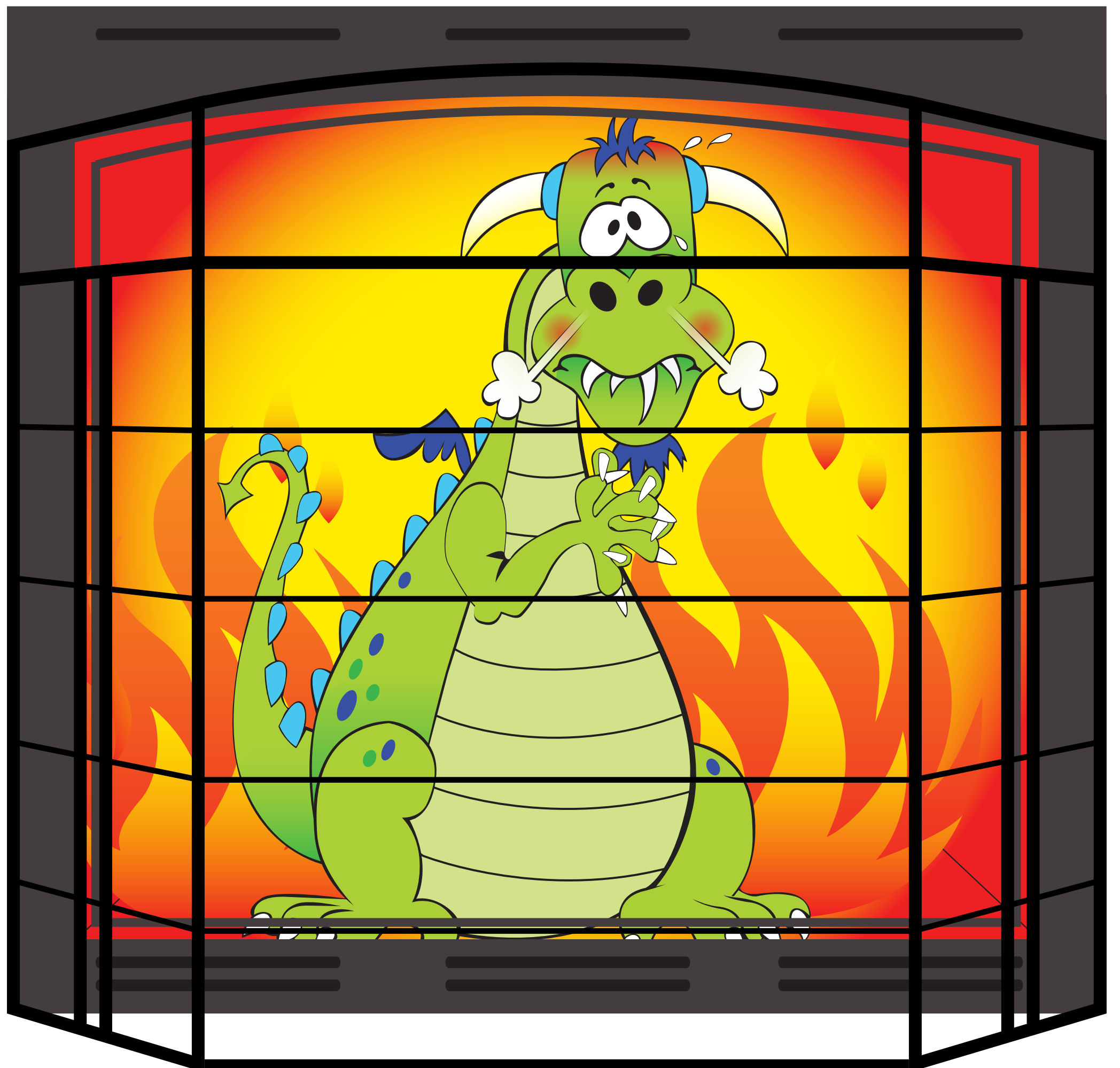
Gas Fireplaces can be as Dangerous as a Fire-Breathing Dragon!

KEEP THE DRAGON AWAY FROM **YOUR CHILD!**

Install a screen over the doors to keep little hands off the hot glass.

KNOW THE FACTS:

- Gas fireplace glass doors can reach excessive temperatures (1,300°F / 704°C).
- Serious burn injuries from the hot glass can happen in less than 1 second.
- Doors remain hot for 1 hour+ after use.
- Install a screen barrier.
- Closely supervise toddlers and young children around fireplaces and use safety gates.
- Make sure fireplace on switches and remote controls are out of the reach of children.
- Restaurants, hotels, and other homes may have gas fireplaces without screens. Keep a close watch on children while you visit.
