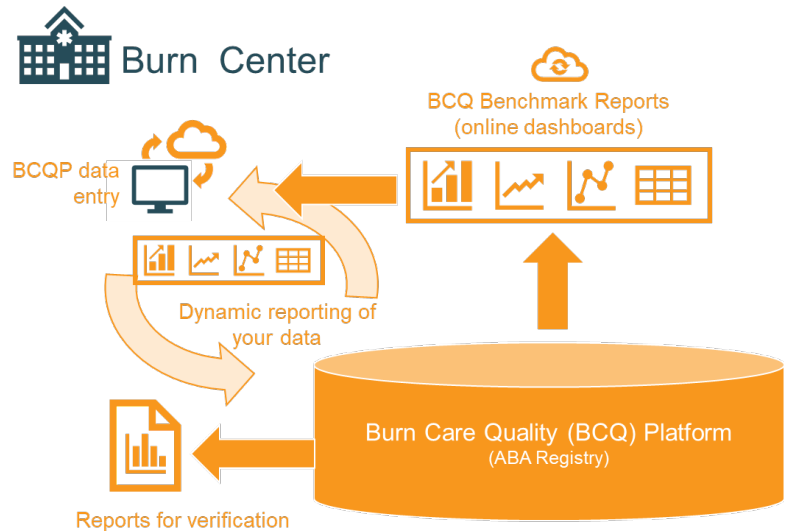




Doing More with Registry Data.

The ABA's new Burn Care Quality Platform (BCQP) expands data reporting options for the ABA's national burn registry.

All data contributors have access to enhanced registry analytics on the new platform. Additionally, the new **BCQP Full Registry** participation option includes secure, cloud-based data entry and enhanced reporting modules, which are designed to replace use of local software for burn data collection.*



Features. By entering patient data directly into the ABA burn registry, instead of waiting for the annual call for data, burn centers take advantage of the opportunity for expanded reporting. An overview of functionality is described in the table here.

Additionally, all data contributors continue to receive a complimentary copy of the annual summary report and discounted pricing for de-identified research data sets.

Fees. The 2020 participation fee for BCQP Full Registry is \$4,500, including 4 platform users
